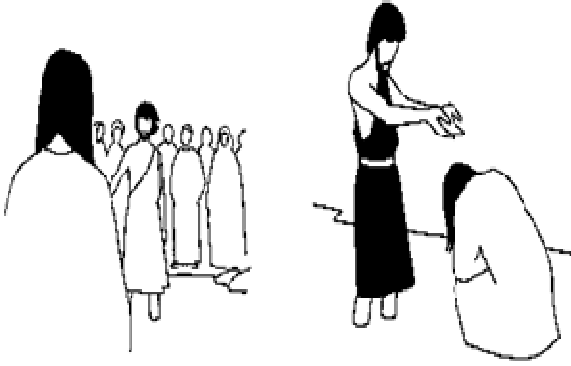

A Mass with a Candlelight Service in memory of our loved ones who have died will be held on: Wednesday, January 27th in Italian.

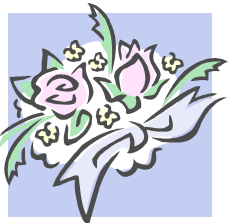
The service starts at 8:00 p.m. Please arrive early to register.

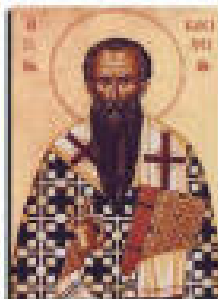

 Tuesday, February 2nd.



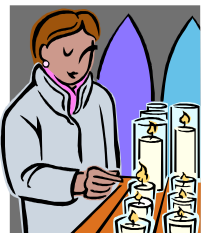
