Haiti Earthquake Relief— ShareLife—2nd Collection January 24th, 2010

The Caribbean nation of Haiti was hit by a 7.0 magnitude earthquake, its strongest in more than 200 years, causing massive damage & loss of lives. An estimated three million people may have been affected by the quake. Tens of thousands of people appear to have lost their homes.

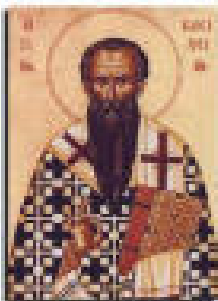
